Road Closures and Parking Restriction

MIKE NIELDS MEMORIAL BANNOCK STREET CRITERIUM 27th ANNUAL BICYCLE RACE

Saturday 17 July 2021

Race starting times from 8:00 AM to 6:30 PM

Please be alerted to the following road closures associated with the upcoming bicycle race in the Golden Triangle community. The closures will also affect traffic patterns within the racecourse. We appreciate your help in spreading the word to your neighbours and business associates. We hope you'll come out & cheer the cyclists.

Full Road Closure will take place on Saturday 17 July 2021 from **4am to 7:45pm**. This is to ensure the safety of racers, spectators, and volunteers. See map for streets affected.

Parking Meters will be (red) bagged on Friday 16 July and ALL PARKING along the racecourse will be PROHIBITED effective 8pm Friday 16 July through 8pm Saturday 17 July. **Any vehicles left on the course will be towed by Denver Police**. Please plan accordingly.

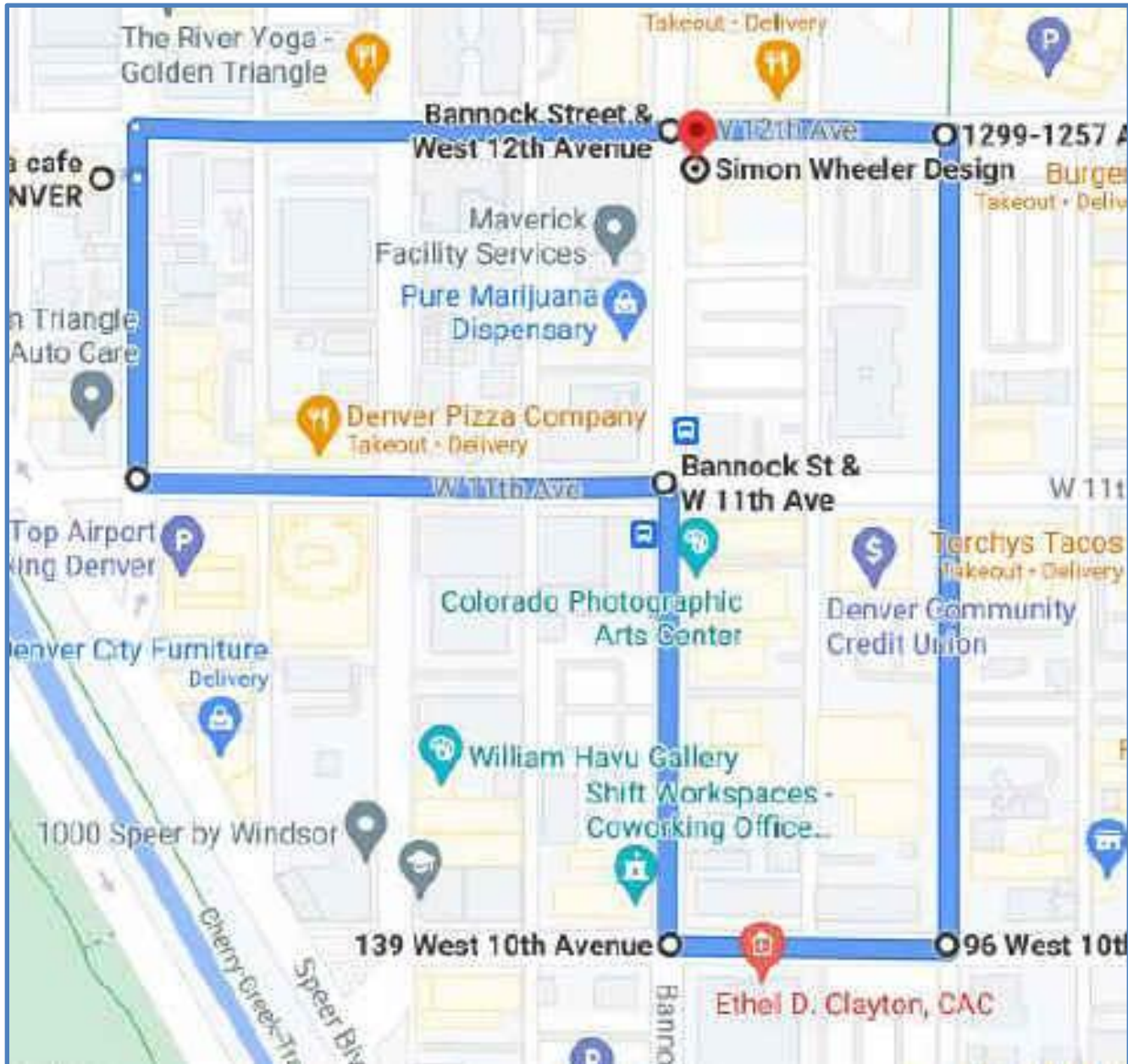
Covid information: The Bannock Street Criterium will follow state and local public health orders and guidelines to ensure a safe event. Everyone working at or attending the event should:

- Stay home if they feel ill
- Is encouraged to wear a mask or face covering!
- Wash hands/use hand sanitizer at the stations provided.

Public Health Orders can change at any time and may require event cancellation with little or no notice.

Controlled Access to residences and business *inside* the course will be managed by course marshals and Denver Police. They will assist you getting by the closures as the racers on the course have passed, when it's safe. Please allow a few extra minutes in your schedule to accommodate the possible delay.

Course Description: Approximately a 1-mile course, bordered by 10th and 12th Avenues, Acoma and Delaware Streets. Start / Finish will be at Bannock Street and 12th Avenues.
